PRIMARY RESIDENTIAL PARKING VIOLATIONS AND ACTION REQUEST

\$50 FINES

Sec. 26-122. Parking for longer than seventy-two hours prohibited.

No person shall park or allow to stand any vehicle on any of the public streets or roadways in the County for a period in excess of seventy-two (72) hours.

Sec. 26-127.01. Parking of unregistered motor vehicles or unregistered trailers.

No person shall park any unregistered motor vehicle or unregistered trailer upon the highways, roads, streets, or other public property in the County at any time.

Sec. 26-127.04. Stopping, standing, or parking prohibited in specified places.

General rule. The provisions of this Section apply except as necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or traffic control device.

Stopping, standing, or parking. No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle:

In front of a public driveway;

On a sidewalk;

Within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant;

Within twenty (20) feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;

Within thirty (30) feet on the approach to any flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign, or traffic control signal located at the side of a roadway;

In a direction other than the flow of traffic;

On an unpaved area of a residential lot that is less than (1) acre in size.

\$50 FINES

Sec. 26-162. Abandoned vehicles prohibited.

No person shall leave any abandoned vehicle at any place within the County.

Abandoned vehicle means any motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer:

That is inoperable and left unattended on public property for more than forty-eight (48) hours;

That has remained on public property for more than forty-eight (48) hours; and

Is not displaying currently valid registration plates; or

That has remained on private property for more than forty-eight (48) hours; and

Is inoperable in that one or more of its major mechanical components, is missing or not functional unless such vehicle is kept in an enclosed building.

Is not displaying currently valid registration plates; or

Any partially dismantled, wrecked, or junked vehicle may be presumed to be abandoned.

\$200 FINES

Sec. 11-277. Fire lanes

You can not park in an area designated as a fire lane.

\$500 FINES

Sec. 26-123. Commercial vehicles

No commercial vehicle (over 10,000 lbs) can be parked on a public street unless they are in the course of a commercial purpose.
